Hand, foot, and mouth disease--a common viral illness that usually affects infants and children younger than 5 years old. However, it can sometimes occur in adults.

Symptoms include: *fever, mouth sores, sore throat, and skin rash.*

A skin rash with red spots, and sometimes with blisters, may also develop over one or two days on the palms of the hands and soles of the feet; it may also appear on the knees and elbows. Students should stay home while they are sick with hand, foot, and mouth disease. There should be no drainage occurring from open sores that are not covered by clothing. Talk with your physician if you are not sure when you should return to school. We have not had any reported cases at our school yet.
